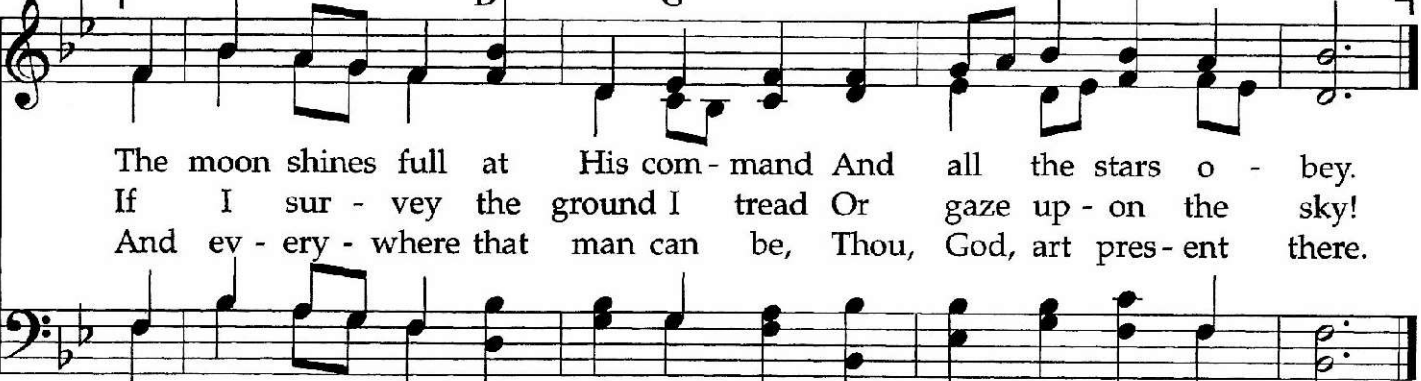
That spread the flow-ing seas a-broad, And built the loft-y skies.
